Dear Valued Customer,

In July of 2010, the United States Congress passed legislation requiring public companies to report the use of “Conflict Minerals” in the manufacture of their products. “Conflict Materials” in this context refers to the following minerals: coltan, cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, which are limited to tantalum, tin, and tungsten.

While still a private company, Superior Sensor Technology is committed to comply with this legislation. We are actively working with our suppliers to understand or establish their systems for the sourcing of these raw materials, especially any minerals listed above which may be used in Superior Sensor Technology products.

Superior Sensor Technology is committed to a conflict-free supply chain. There are no known Conflict Minerals in our products that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or adjoining countries.
