

Statement on REACH Compliance

On June 1, 2007, the European Regulation No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation Authorization Restriction of Chemical (“REACH Regulation”) entered into force. The REACH Regulation identifies substances of very high concern (SVHC). Any substance defined by European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) as being of very high concern must not be used manufactured or imported without the prior authorization of the Agency once it has been included on a list given in Annex XIV of the REACH Regulation, website shown below:

Identified SVHC’s must be notified to the Agency when the substance is present:

- In total shipments over 1 metric ton per producer/importer per year; and
- Above a concentration of 0.1% by weight

Superior Sensor Technology have determined that its products do not contain any listed SVHC per the ECHA list last updated June 10, 2022 (REACH-224), in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight.

As part of our SVHC identification process we do the following:

- Review internal / publicly available engineering data and safety data sheets in relation to the presence of SVHCs in our products or their component parts:
- Communicate with our suppliers to confirm/exclude the presence of SVHCs in the component part of our products.

Please note that the company has not conducted any specific tests to determine the presence of these SVHC substances. If you have any additional questions, please contact the local Superior Sensor Technology sales representative.
